Mr. PÉREZ ALVAREZ received his Law Degree (1983) and Ph. D. in Law (1988) from University of Salamanca; and he also obtained a M.S. in Human Rights and European Studies (1987), in the Pontifical University of Salamanca; getting with honoreach of these degrees. He has been mainly to teaching and research. Since 1989, he is Professor at the University of Salamanca, teaching Criminal Law at the undergraduate and Postgraduate Studies. *He also has taught lectures and given conferences in different public institutions in Spain and Latin America.*

He currently heads the Institute for Security Sciences (CISE) at the University of Salamanca, since 1997, directing the Further Studies in Criminology, Private Investigation and Public Security. He also heads, since 2010 the Telefonica Professorship Security Research.
